This 50th Anniversary Annual Report is dedicated to the memory of the founder of the Mount Abarim Baptist Mission, Dr. Ralph McCoy. His faithful dedication to prayer, zeal for the Word of God, love for his family, and selflessness in every aspect of his life are an example for all missionaries.

After wrestling with God over a call to the ministry, Bro. McCoy sold his earthly possessions and left for Bible College in 1944. In 1954, the Ralph McCoy family began a journey of faith as full-time missionaries. Their legacy includes the thousands of young men and women who have come

through the Bethesda Children's Homes, well over one hundred churches planted in Mexico and Central America, and four generations of descendants that are serving the Lord.

As Dr. McCoy prepared to go to the mis-

Schmidt had preached a powerful sermon, Dr. McCoy led his church to take up a special offering for the missionary. ### THE PRESIDENT'S PAGE

This year marks the Golden Anniversary of God's work through the Mount Abarim Baptist Mission. Our founder, Dr. Ralph McCoy, believed in the Biblical model of missionaries being under the authority and direction of their sending church. He also understood the need that missionaries face in communicating with their sponsoring churches and started a mission to bridge the gap between missionaries and their churches.

Over the past year, it has been my joy to visit many of our missionaries on their respective fields. As I visited our missionaries in Ghana, Spain, and Mexico, my heart rejoiced at God's goodness. Two trips to Mongolia were also greatly blessed. Many souls are being saved, churches are being planted, and lives are being changed every single day. It is exciting to be part of something that is so great that only God could take the credit for it.

This year's report contains brief synopses from many of our missionaries. There are many others who are not included. Over one hundred seventy missionary families in over thirty countries receive help in one way or another through our offices in the US and Mexico and the Calvary Baptist Church of Techiman, Ghana.

#### We would like to request your special consideration of the following seven special needs:

1. Conference Expense: (Total need - \$35,000) Travel expenses for speakers & missionaries \$10,000; printed material for conference \$5,000; building use and appreciation gifts for helpers \$5,000; conference meals \$15,000. 2. Bethesda Children's Homes' Annual Reunion and Retreat: (Total need \$10,000). The annual reunion is for the children who grew up in the Bethesda Children's Homes, of which nearly 600 were present last year. The retreat is a yearly opportunity for the staff to spiritually prepare for the upcoming year working with the children. 3. Computers for the Mexican Office of Mt. Abarim (Total need - \$2,000). The eleven year-old computers have been repaired many times, but they finally died.

4. New Krobo Church Building: (Total need - <u>\$7,000</u>). This building is well underway, but finances are needed to finish. At least \$3,000 is needed to make it useable; and \$7,000 will finish it.

5. The main Techiman church building request is <u>\$6,000</u>. They are building in stages a very big building to seat over 1,000 people. The need for the current stage is \$20,000 which will get the basic frame of the church poured. They have already raised \$14,000; so we want to encourage them with the remaining \$6,000.

6. Calvary Baptist Church in Jama (near Bui) has just finished pouring their foundation, but needs <u>\$5,000</u> to continue with the pillars, walls, window frames, and lintel. What a blessing you could be to these people! 7. MIT 2016 Program: (<u>\$5,000</u>). The Missionary-in-Training Program is a new ministry for mentoring high school students interested in missions. This fund will finance all the work involved in organizing and preparing for the MIT 2016 Program.

Please keep the ministries of Mount Abarim in your daily prayers. As Dr. Raymond Barber says in *Gold Mine of Knowledge*:

"Praying pews and powerful pulpits make perfect partners."

### **BIBLE TRANSLATION DIRECTOR'S REPORT**



#### **Bible translation assistants in Mongolia**

The highlight of 2015 was the completion of the translation of the New Testament into Mongolian. This project began in May of 2008. Oyumaa and I are continuing to work with FirstBible and Trinitarian Bible Society in the procedures to check the text prior to its printing. We are still hopeful for a printing in the Spring

and a dedicatory service soon afterward.

Also in 2015, we finished our part on the revision of the Spanish Reina-Valera New Testament. This is the first time the Spanish New Testament has been revised on the same textual basis as the original translation. We have been working on this project since 2006 and are very grateful to the Lord for His help to have come this far. Please pray for the team that will continue to revise the Old Testament, although we will not be a part of that team.

We continue to partner with Bible translators in several languages as consultants. Please pray that God would direct our steps regarding a project with which we might become more closely involved. We would be especially grateful if the Lord would send us a young man or lady whom we could train in this great task.

Dear Friends: I was again asked to list our needs. At this stage of our ministry, I am more inclined to give than to ask for more, not because we do not have needs, but because we know of far more pressing needs of others. Often I have been too candid in presenting needs that only God can meet and frustrated our dear friends. Our God has been a wonderful provider. I believe the Lord has been teaching us to trust Him and for that reason, I ask for only your prayers.

Over the last year I suffered four heart attacks, two heart ablation surgeries, and the placing of four stents. But God allowed me to live. I finished cardiac rehab in August and began traveling to meetings in September.

We had meetings in Mexico and all over the southern and eastern parts of the United States. The Holy Spirit blessed in these meetings with many souls saved;

lives were changed, and others gave their lives to serve as missionaries. I am humbled by His goodness.

We were able to raise the funds and complete the building of the tribal church in Tepeyac. God moved His omnipotent hand and over \$40,000 was provided to complete the building without debt. I was able to preach the dedication in September despite the 7200 ft. altitude. (I did have an oxygen bottle with me, and it helped before and after my message.)

Our children are all active in His service. Our grandchildren are walking in His ways, and two are now in

college. In February, Allison presented us with our tenth grandchild. Lillie Kate Anderson is a welcome addition to the family. She is expecting another child in July. May our tribe increase!

I do not know what the future holds, but I

do know that it is as Allison with Lillie Kate bright as the promises of God. We love you and thank you for every prayer and every sacrifice that have made our ministry possible.

### THE INTERNATIONAL FUND--2016 REPORT

### FUNDING SERVICES AT HOME AND ABROAD

The International Fund has been a special blessing to many in 2015. We were able to grant a dozen Ralph G. McCoy scholarships and grants to Bible College students in the United States as well as two full ride scholarships for young preachers from the homes in Tlapa. We also took care of the travel expenses for the young men from Tlapa and their chaperone in their move to college.

Through the International Fund we are helping tribal evangelists, college students, church plants and missionaries on the field. We were able to fund one of the tickets for the Acosta family who are leaving for Nicaragua after this meeting as church planters. We have had a busy year.

- We completed building the church in Tepeyac that was destroyed after Mexico's hurricane. With land purchase and materials costing about \$40,000 U.S.D., the church capacity was quadrupled in a well-engineered building that should withstand earthquakes, mudslides, and hurricanes. Help for this project came through the International Fund. We were with them for the September dedication.
- The Lord provided and we were able to fund our international trips without using I.F. funds. Over the years we have traveled to over 40 countries on five continents.
- When an emergency health issue for one of the boys in the Rios de Misericordia required a prolonged stay in the hospital, we were able to help with his medical expenses. He has recovered.

The International Fund needs your help. We presently have about a dozen monthly supporters and a few that send special offerings. We do need monthly support. Asking others to sacrifice is often difficult...that is not the case with the International Fund. So much has been accomplished with so little. Becky and I still invest in this fund every week. We consider it a wise eternal investment.

Dr. McCoy never expected anyone to reach his level of sacrifice for the Tlapa children. He simply shared his heart and people wanted to help. It is my prayer that for a little while you can glimpse my heart in seeing not only the pressing needs of the children but also this worldwide outreach.

### 2015 REPORT & 2016 BUDGET NEEDS FOR HOMES

From September through early December we traveled in meetings and used my book signings to help fill some gaps in the support for the homes. Special Christmas offerings were received and all of the funds from the sale of *MY PEOPLE* have been given to the homes. Christmas bonuses were paid, and all of the children received special treats in December, but we desperately need help for the Christian School. It has been a very fruitful year. The children and staff led over 2000 people to Christ this year in Tlapa.

- **1.** We presently have seven children in need of sponsors at \$100 per month. Their photos and stories are available. (This does not include tuition and expenses for the Christian day school.)
- 2. Bethesda Centurion Club—"One of one-hundred project." We desperately need one-hundred Christian school sponsors at \$25.00 each month to cover the basic financial needs of our school. This covers our actual cost for curriculum and materials and part of the teacher's salaries. This award winning Christian School has been a lifesaver. The unstable government schools have been on strike for months at a time. Funds for this need largely came from two dear friends and supporters that have experienced financial reverses and could not continue with their \$3000 in combined monthly support. The poor tribal children cannot pay tuition.
- 3. Uniforms for 150 children and staff at \$50.00 each.
- 4. Alumni Reunion \$5500 (about 600 attended this year.) Mexican Staff 3 day Retreat \$4500
- 5. Special Meals for anniversary, Easter, Christmas, and graduation. \$1000 each.
- 6. Aguinaldos for staff (bonuses mandated by Mexican law in the month of December) \$7000

P.S. Miraculous special end of year offerings allowed us to finish the year in the black. A special gift from the Liberty Baptist Church of Las Vegas, Nevada, came at a time of desperate need. We offer special thanks to Dr. Teis and his generous church.

Greetings from the Mt. Abarim Missions Office in Arlington, Texas. We wish to thank those who support the Home Office, both financially and spiritually through your prayers. While our work is mostly behind the scenes, it is vitally important in supporting our missionaries while they spread the gospel in countries around the world. This work includes: • Documenting and depositing support funds received for our missionaries.

- Documenting and depositing support funds received for our missionaries.
- Working with our donors to provide them with needed information to keep them connected with their missionaries.
- Sending receipts and thank you letters each week to the supporters of our missionaries.
- Promoting communication between missionaries and donors by mailing monthly prayer letters and other correspondence.
- Assisting missionaries in their financial responsibilities here in the States while they are out of the country.
- Making required filings to the government and helping missionaries work with local and foreign governments.
- Answering inquiries from missionaries, supporting churches, and individuals.
- Assisting in coordinating the annual Mt. Abarim Missions Conference.

During this year, Mt. Abarim financial statements and supporting documentation for calendar year 2014 were audited by an independent Certified Public Accountant. All financial statements were properly documented and accounted for and present an accurate and fair reflection of the Mission's financial position and operations.

### THE MEXICAN OFFICE REPORT

We serve missionaries worldwide. I am a certified public accountant, and my goal as the Office Director is to be a blessing. Some of our expenses are carried by the Iglesia Bautista Monte Abarim. Dr. Mike Patterson has helped with our deficits of about \$500 each month, but I know this has been a great personal sacrifice with their heavy medical expenses. (We need \$500 in monthly support.) In addition we had to replace our eleven year old computers. After many repairs, two of them just died. We simply did not have the funds; so Dr. Patterson helped with this need until the funds are supplied. We still need \$2000.

We began the Mexican office in the year 2000. Dr. Patterson shared his vision to help the growing tribe of Mexican missionaries, and it soon became my burden as well. We now serve about 60 families with deposits, monthly reports, and mailing services. Our own son, who is in Spain, was the first to receive our help sixteen years ago. We pray for our missionary friends daily. When tragedy hits, we do everything within our power to help.

"Wherein ye were also careful, but ye lacked opportunity" (Phil. 4:10)." HERE IS THE OPPORTUNITY! Please help us help our Mexican missionaries. They are now serving all over the world.

### **BRAZILIAN FIELD DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

As we look back on 2015, we see our Lord's guiding hand over our lives and ministries. Brazil is facing its worst financial and political crisis in years, much worse than the 2008 crisis in the USA. From without, the fall of the prices of commodities compromised a great source of Brazil's income. From within, grave corruption scandals in all levels of government and overspending have jeopardized Brazil's credibility, causing the dollar rate to almost double what it was a year ago. This dramatic rise in the dollar rate has benefited missionary families and is making this a prime time to invest in Brazil. We do not know how long the Dollar will remain high; therefore, we must use this opportunity to further the Gospel in Brazil!

This was my first year serving as the Brazilian Field Director, and I count this a great honor and joy! It is a joy to serve with others of like faith and the same love, striving together for the same goal, the fulfilling of the great commission of our Lord Jesus Christ. The Lord has given us a unique opportunity to serve him as a family, alongside my father (Tom Gilmer) and brother-in-law (Rom Ribeiro). These two great men of God do not give me an ounce of trouble, but rather fill my heart with encouragement!

I have the privilege of serving alongside my father at the Trinitarian Bible Society of Brazil, of which he is president and I am executive (general) secretary. The scenario in Brazil for Bible publication has changed significantly in the past few months, placing us in the face of difficult times, particularly with Brazil enduring a recession. We do not now have the warehousing space that we used to have made available to us by our printers, and the rise in the US dollar has caused our production costs to almost double. However, these difficulties helped us define our role in worldwide missions: To service churches by supplying faithful editions of the Holy Scriptures to (1) local churches, (2) members of churches, and (3) unsaved people, being instrumental in bringing them to Christ. We will also work together in team church planting, and we are preparing for the start of one more church soon, the Lord willing.

This year we had the joy of visiting Rom and Rachel in the city of Ribeirão Preto (just four hours away from São Paulo), where they just started their fifth church. Please send an e-mail to either Bro. Rom or myself for a link to

### **AFRICAN FIELD DIRECTOR'S REPORT**



#### The Chief of Atebubu trusts Christ!

Looking back over this year, we have so much to be thankful for. Returning to Africa in February, I tried my best to visit as many of our missionaries as possible to encourage and help them in their ministries. In March, we held the building dedication service for the <u>Adutwie</u> church. Seven got saved, and two surrendered to preach. Then two weeks later, we broke ground for the new church plant on the <u>Bamire Road</u> in Techiman. Right from there we jumped into our big <u>Easter outreach</u> with a special visit from our president, <u>Dr. Bill Patterson</u>. This year we had the joy of leading <u>450</u> people to Christ in our eleven churches in the Techiman district! In the days before and after Easter, I also visited our missionaries in Bui, Jama, Bolgatanga, Kudagu, and Cape Coast. I saw nine people baptized.

Due to the big Ebola scare, some people who normally come to Africa didn't. So this year we had the joy of hosting some last minute, but wonderful people. Three students from Crown College, our Pastor from Bible Baptist Church in Chickasha, and my parents helped us with our yearly school camp ministry and the new church plant in Atebubu. Three weeks before we went to Atebubu to start the church, I went with a small team of pastors and had the joy of leading their 90 year old chief to trust in Christ as Savior. We have been able to buy land and acquire our building permit to start work in January 2016.

Please pray about coming to Africa to visit us on a "life-changing" missions trip. We promise you the Lord will open your eyes in a way you have never seen before as you see the believers in Africa work together to help the lost know Him as Savior!
